



### **Information For The Teacher**

These decoding and comprehension tests can be used with the following books.

- Phonetic Words And Stories, Books 5, 6, 7, 8
- Basic Phonics Patterns, Books 5-6 And 7-8
- Know The Phonetic Code, Volumes 2 And 3

This book can be used along with the *Phonics Patterns Workbook For Books 5-8*, which provides practice reading and spelling the ten new words for each phonetic pattern taught in the *Phonetic Words And Stories* books.

Answer keys are provided at the end of this book.

Provide guidance, modeling, and assistance to students as needed when they are learning how to complete the pages in this book. When students are able to complete the pages independently, follow up by checking the answers as a group. This allows you and the students to discover any problem areas that need support and further explanation.

Work with the students as a whole group when they begin completing the written comprehension questions for the stories. Have students read each question aloud. Invite students to provide oral answers. Record several answers for each question on the board, discussing spelling, word spacing, capitalization, and punctuation as needed. Help students elaborate on their answers by having them discuss the story in response to your prompts. For each question, you can proceed using one or more of the choices below.

- Students choose their favorite answer and copy it onto their papers.
- Students choose to write their own answer, which may be different from the choices shown on the board.
- Students can combine two or more of the answers on the board and write them on their papers.

After students have practiced in this way for a period of time, you can alter this sequence. Have students read the written comprehension questions on their own and write their responses independently. When students have completed this section, work with them as a group to review their answers. Call on volunteers to read their answers aloud. Write some of the responses on the board. Use these to discuss how well the question has been answered. Is there a way to clarify the answer or expand on it? Elicit answers from the students and model the editing process on the board. Also have students check their work to make sure they have correct spelling, capitalization, and punctuation, providing guidance as needed.

## An Alternate Testing Approach

You could also use these pages as both a teaching tool and a testing tool.

- 1. Teach the new pattern and cover the teaching pages in the student book and phonics workbook.
- 2. Do the pages in this decoding and comprehension book as a group, doing one item at a time, working together. Ask for students' responses and provide feedback, clarification, and assistance as needed. Monitor the students to be sure they understand each item and have it filled in correctly. Have students complete the written comprehension questions as described on the previous page, working with you as a group.
- 3. The next day, give students a fresh copy of the decoding, comprehension. and written comprehension pages that were done together. This time, students complete the pages independently, without any help.
