## How To Use This Book

There are three sets of Sound City Reading books that can be used at Level 4, Phonics Patterns. Each set of books covers the same phonetic patterns in the same order and includes the same set of easy, decodable practice stories. But each set of books is printed in a different format, as described below.

Phonetic Words And Stories - Books 1-8 - The print is very large, with color-coded vowels. Each vowel sound is printed in a specific color to make the vowels stand out in the words. Ten new words are introduced for each new phonics pattern or syllable pattern. There are two columns of the same words for each pattern. In the first column, there are arrows between the letters and letter patterns for each word. The words in the second column are printed normally. The words are printed on the right hand page, and the matching pictures are shown on the left hand page, in a different order. This allows the teacher to do a combined phonemic awareness/decoding exercise with the students when introducing each set of words. This set of books is ideal for all younger students or older students who have dyslexia or other learning difficulties.

Basic Phonics Patterns - Books 1, 2, 3, 4, 5-6, 7-8 - These books have all black print. In most cases, more than ten words are introduced for each new phonics pattern or syllable pattern. A small picture beside each word illustrates its meaning.

Know The Phonetic Code - Volumes 1, 2, 3 - These books contain one and two-syllable word lists for each phonetic pattern and syllable pattern. They can be used as a review of the phonics patterns with students who have already learned to read. The words are not illustrated, but the practice stories are illustrated.

1. Use this workbook with book one of any of the level four Sound City Reading books. The phonics patterns in this workbook are arranged in the same sequence as the patterns in book one. Students should practice reading each set of words and sentences in their books, under the supervision of the teacher, then do the related workbook pages. The teacher should provide guidance and support with the workbook pages at all times as needed.
2. Students should be sure to use their best handwriting. Teach handwriting as needed.
3. Some of the words in this workbook may be new to students. Be sure to explain the meaning of any unknown words.
4. The small pictures on the word sort pages are from A Sound Story About Audrey And Brad. Read this story aloud to the students. Each picture in the story represents a specific speech sound.
5. Congratulate the students on taking a big step towards becoming independent readers and writers.
